Rules of Entry

1. \$10.00 entry fee. Free for AAC members. AAC membership is available for \$50 a year; membership also allows free entry into annual Curatorial Review. For info call (215)887-4882.
2. Each artist may submit two (2) entries of any medium created in the last three years, not previously exhibited at AAC.
3. All work must be clearly labeled. Hanging works must be properly framed and wired. No clip frames. Size must be limited to 60 inches in any direction and 75lbs overall. All works, particularly 3-D works must be stable and able to be handled.
4. Fill out the entry form and labels (on back) completely.

AAC reserves the right to exclude any work which presents difficulty in size or installation, or does not adhere to rules of entry. Every precaution will be taken to handle works safely and with care. Works selected for exhibition will be subject to AAC's fine arts coverage. Any work left after 30 days from the appropriate return date will become property of the Art Center.

Juror • Julien Robson

Curator of Contemporary Art at the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts (PAFA), Julien Robson relocated to Philadelphia in 2008 after eight years in Louisville, Kentucky where he was Curator of Contemporary Art at the Speed Art Museum and Adjunct Professor at the University of Louisville. A native of Scotland, Robson initially trained as an artist at Bath Academy of Art, and the Slade School of Fine Art in London before taking up curatorial positions at the University of Sussex and, subsequently, the University of Southampton, England. During the 1990s Robson lived in Austria, working in the commercial gallery sector in Vienna, and in 1998 he spent six months as Guest Professor at the University of California, Santa Barbara.
