Materials List

Experienced painters are welcome to bring any painting materials you already have and work in pastel, oil, acrylic, or watercolor.

The following watercolor painting items are recommended if you are new to painting. Demonstrations will be in watercolor.

Paints: Individual tubes of professional grade paints are recommended.

(**If you are just starting out, 5 ml tubes of the colors listed in **BOLD*** will be sufficient.)

- Cadmium Red
- **Alizarin Crimson***
- **Winsor Yellow ***
- Yellow Ochre
- **French Ultramarine Blue***
- Prussian Blue
- **Winsor Green Yellow Shade***
- Viridian Green
- **Brown Madder***
- **Sepia* (suggested watercolor brand - M.Graham)**
- Payne's Gray

Palette Folded Plastic, with empty compartments for your paint is recommended.

Round Brushes - 2 sizes, Medium - size 10, Small - size 4. Sable recommended.

Wash Brush - Larger brush that holds more paint. Squirrel hair or other natural hair recommended.

Surface - 140 lb Watercolor paper, 9 x 12 inches or larger. A watercolor block or loose 22 x 30 inch sheet divided into quarters will work well.

Sketchbook (4 x 6 inches or larger) If you already have one, bring it!

Pencil (2B recommended) & **Eraser** (kneaded eraser or plastic)

Other Recommended Materials:

- Rags and/or absorbent paper towels**
- Container with a wide mouth for water**
- Masking Tape**
- Ruler**
- Viewfinder**
- Hat / Sunscreen / Bug spray**
